



- •Aim: securing sustainable supplies of raw materials
- ·Launched in 2008, consolidated in 2011
- Non-energy, non-agricultural raw materials
- Connecting EU external and internal policies
- Integrated strategy (3 pillars)
- •Introduced list of Critical Raw Materials (CRM) in 2011 and 2014



EIP targets 2020



- Up to 10 innovative pilot actions e.g. demonstration pilot plants for exploration, mining, processing, collecting and recycling
- Substitutes for at least 3 applications of critical raw materials
- Regulatory framework for primary raw materials
- Regulatory framework for secondary raw materials
- Raw materials knowledge base with raw materials flows and trends
- Raw materials network of Research, Education and Training Centres
- Pro-active international cooperation strategy of EU at bilateral and multilateral level









New Call for Raw Materials Commitments (RMC)

was launched at the end of 2015

DEADLINE March 1, 2016







- The Raw Materials Commitment could have multiple positive effects such as:
 - Promoting ideas in the area of raw materials,
 - Attracting useful suggestions or additional partners,
 - A higher rate of success in Horizon 2020, a higher chance of funding under the EU structural funds (even though the European Innovation Partnership as such is not a funding instrument),
 - Possibility to influence policy, and several others ...






